## Queuing at Edinburgh Waverley

Queuing plans are in place at Edinburgh Waverley on Sunday 6 September and customers are asked to note that they may be unable to travel on their intended service. Please follow the instructions of staff at the station.

## GroupSave

Get together and save with our great value GroupSave, tickets available for three or four people travelling together. Travel between Glasgow and Edinburgh from as little as £5.20\* return each. There's no need to book in advance, just turn up, book your ticket and hop on the train.

**GroupSave** tickets are valid for travel on off-peak ScotRail services between Edinburgh and Glasgow Queen Street, including journeys between Glasgow and Linlithgow/Polmont/Falkirk High and between Edinburgh and Bishopbriggs/Lenzie/Croy/Falkirk High/Polmont/Linlithgow.

You can travel on any service at weekends, and after 9.15am Monday to Friday, excluding services departing Edinburgh Waverley, Haymarket and Glasgow Queen Street between 4.45pm and 6.15pm. Available every day except 5-6 September.
